

American Rescue Act



Because this is a reconciliation bill, it is primarily about funding levels. Breakdown of the \$1 billion dollars to AmeriCorps agency with green text showing 2021 approp passed in Dec 2020:

- **\$620 million** for AmeriCorps State and National to **increase living allowances** and to increase **existing grants** and **award new grants** with priority on:
 - ✓ entities serving communities disproportionately impacted by COVID-19 who use culturally competent and multilingual strategies in the provision of services; and
 - ✓ taking into account the diversity of communities and participants served by such entities, including racial, ethnic, socioeconomic, linguistic, or geographic diversity.

- **\$20 million** for **State Commissions to make new awards** and **adjust existing awards**, including awards to commissions

- **\$20 million** for the Volunteer Generation Fund
